Window to expect Election Day results to be reported



7:45 PM Mail Voting (CAP) Results Reported *(approximate time)*



8:30 PM Early Voting Results Reported *(approximate time)*

9:30 PM Election Day Results Reported *Ongoing until complete*

Wednesday, November 6

10:00 AM Canvass of Results

Day-long process where officer teams check all results reported online match the scanner tapes.

12:00 PM Provisional Hearing

Voters who cast a provisional ballot can provide additional evidence to the PWC Electoral Board as to why their vote should be counted.

Friday, November 8

12:00 PM Deadline for Mail Ballots to Arrive

Must have been postmarked by 7pm on November 5th.

Friday, November 8 - Saturday, November 9

ALL DAY CAP (Central Absentee Precinct) Post-Election

Officer teams review and count mail ballots that arrived on or after Election Day.

Wednesday, November 13 - Thursday, November 14

10:00 AM Provisional Adjudication Meeting *Ongoing until complete*

PWC Electoral Board reviews eligibility of all Provisional Ballots, and recommends which should be counted in the election.

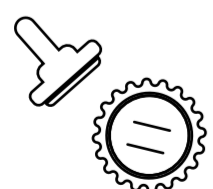
Friday, November 15

9:00 AM Results Certification by PWC Electoral Board

All entered results receive a final review by the local Electoral Board to ensure accuracy.

4:00 PM Results Tapes Posted Online

Scans of all the original ballot scanner results tapes are posted online so that the public may review and compare to the online results reported to the state.
